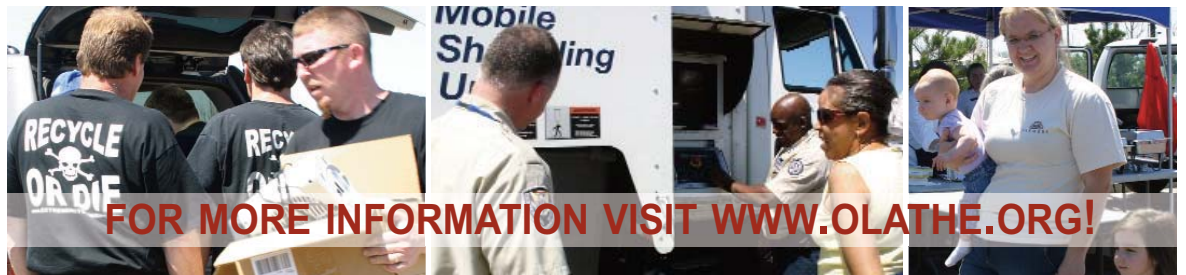
- Attend free City of Olathe presentations at HealthRidge Fitness and learn from local experts how to be "Good Neighbors and Good Stewards of the Earth."
