### INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

## BEDROOM FIRE CAUSES EVACUATION

A bedroom fire at Temporary Lodging for Children & Families caused an estimated \$30,000 in damages last night. TLC staff immediately evacuated 12 residents from the building when the fire alarm sounded and alerted them to the fire.

Firefighters stopped the fire from spreading to the rest of the building by containing it to the bedroom in which it started. Fire damaged the room and its contents while smoke traveled throughout the building.

The displaced residents were quickly provided additional lodging by TLC.

An Olathe fire investigator determined the fire's cause to be intentional. Working with Olathe police officers, a male juvenile in his teens was taken into custody and charged with aggravated arson.
