



The **Emergency Services Section** is responsible for daily emergency services response. Seven fire stations with eight staffed units deploy personnel twenty-four hours a day 365 days a year to fires, medical emergencies, rescue calls, natural and man-made disasters as well as other calls for service. Uniform personnel maintain equipment in a state of readiness, participate in training, educate the public, and conduct life safety inspections as part of a daily routine.

The Department's **Special Operations Section** is comprised of the Logistics & Support Services Division, Training & Safety Division, and Building Code Division. Special Operations is responsible for providing services in support of the department's daily mission and direction of Special Events Planning, Emergency Management, Technical Rescue, Hazardous Materials, and Explosive Ordnances Disposal Response.

The **Community Risk Management Section** is responsible for fire prevention by providing services in fire inspections, fire/explosion investigations, public education, and fire plan reviews.
