



### **Curbside Recycling Materials collected:**

**Mixed Paper** – The City accepts newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, mixed office paper.

*How to prepare:* The paper must be dry and either placed loosely in the bin, tied in bundles, or bagged in brown paper sacks.

*Unacceptable items:* telephone books (collected in June and July only)

**Plastic** – The City accepts PET #1 plastic containers and HDPE #2 plastic containers with a neck (there should be either a “1” or a “2” on the bottom of the container).

*Examples:* soft drink and water bottles, detergent and shampoo bottles, milk jugs, etc.

*How to prepare:* Please rinse containers and remove caps and rings

*Unacceptable items:* Plastic containers that are marked other than numbers 1 and 2, plastic bags, or containers from household hazardous wastes (motor oils, pesticides, etc.)

**Glass** – The City accepts clear, green, or brown glass food or beverage bottles.

*How to prepare:* The glass must be unbroken. Please rinse containers and remove caps and rings.

*Unacceptable items:* flat glass (window glass or mirrors), dishware, or broken glass of any kind.

**Aluminum/Tin** – The City accepts Aluminum and tin food containers.

*How to prepare:* Please rinse containers; place lids inside the can and pinch closed.

*Unacceptable items:* aerosol cans, coat hangers, or scrap metal.
