

Permit Requirements

A cross connection permit is required before installing a new irrigation system or plumbing system that requires a backflow preventer. Only a Johnson County licensed plumber or the homeowner may install an irrigation system for residential dwellings. For commercial properties, only a Johnson County licensed plumber may install plumbing. When a backflow is being replaced, a permit is also required.

- One application is required **PER** assembly
- Residential-\$35.00
- Commercial-\$50.00
- You must go to building codes to apply for permits
- When the permit is issued, the applicant will receive a City of Olathe test report, a red card and a hang bag.
- When replacing a backflow preventer, please include old assembly information and reason for replacement.
- After the installation and testing are complete, a final inspection call must be made within 180 days at the number below.

***** WATER ONE FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**

Disconnection/Capping

Disconnection or removal of a plumbing system that also requires a backflow preventer requires a plumbing permit and inspection from building codes. Documentation from a company will not be accepted. Plumbing systems are to be disconnected 6" to 12" from where the tap is into the service line and made available for inspection. Plumbing permit fees are the same as Cross Connect Permits.
