

2019 - 2020 Comprehensive Listing of Fees & Charges



Charges and fees are used by state and local governments across the country to pay for services provided such as water and sewer utilities, solid waste collection, recreational activities and miscellaneous items such as animal licensing. Many fees are discretionary for residents, meaning they can choose to pay for the services, such as when a resident pays the fee to play in a softball league and receives the services of using the City's facilities and paid umpires. Other charges and fees are less discretionary, such as solid waste fees and water and sewer utility fees.

Fees in the City of Olathe are adopted as part of the budget process. The fee changes are effective January 1 of 2019 unless otherwise noted.
