

Carjacking



You can be attacked by a carjacker:

- in broad daylight
- during rush hour
- at intersections
- in traffic
- in a parking lot

Tips to protect you and your car:

- Roll up your windows and lock your doors.
- Don't allow a crook to jump in an unlocked passenger door.
- Don't ask questions if someone tries to jump into your car.
- Drive away quickly but safely!
- Store your valuables out of sight.
- Don't get trapped in a traffic lane.
- Allow an escape route.
- Leave at least one car length between you and the car in front.
- Trust your instincts.
- Don't exit your car to examine damage.
- Stay in your locked vehicle if you feel suspicious.
- Drive to a safe public place if you feel suspicious.
- Remain at the scene of a serious accident.
- Remain at the scene if you are injured.
